Administrative Changes

In late April, following Brother Paul's retirement, Father P.J. Pabatao, in his role as canonical pastor of All Saints Parish, which comprises All Saints Mission, Saint Anne Mission and Our Lady of the Rosary Mission, asked me if the resident religious staff at Saint Anne Mission could take on administrative oversight responsibilities at All Saints in Ganado. After some discussion, and following assurances that Mr. Mike Sandoval would remain at All Saints as Administrative Assistant and that Mrs. Teresa Gorman would continue as Director of Religious Education and catechist, Sister Monica and I agreed that we could help.

Following Brother Paul's departure, we began the work of cleaning and sorting through the items in his trailer residence. Through that process, it came to light that the mobile home, if it is able to be utilized at all, is in need of a major overhaul. At the very least, new flooring and a new door will need to be purchased and installed. There are also unseen cracks in the structure that are giving access to large rodents.

In April, May, and June, with the help of volunteer student groups from New Hampshire, Louisiana, and New Jersey, we undertook a major cleaning of the Hall as well as scraping and repainting the exterior of All Saints Church. More significant repairs and renovations are under consideration for the future.
