VIRTUS Training

The Diocese requires all clergy, religious, seminarians, employees, volunteer leaders responsible for youth programs and those volunteers who work directly with minors or vulnerable persons (including eucharistic ministers) to attend a VIRTUS Training session and to follow a subsequent program of regular updates to remain current.
